"Village People"

While taking down all the Christmas decorations, one of the first to go 'back in the box' was my 'Thomas Kincade Christmas Village'. With their snowy scenes and warm lights, the putting away of this specific holiday 'trimming' reminds me of one thing... when the village came down, the Christmas season was truly over.

"No one has ever seen God. But if we love each other, God lives in us, and his love is brought to full expression in us." 1 John 4:12
