"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." Ephesians 2:8-10

Last week we introduced our 2024 theme: "Grace Moves / Faith Proves" as we began with the first chapter of Ephesians. Paul had a special relationship with the church in Ephesus - even living there to preach & encourage the church for up to 3 years! And for a 'missionary preacher' who stayed in most towns just long enough to plant a church & head to the next location to do the same, why stay in Ephesus for an extended period of time? Besides the daily discussions in the hall of Tyrannus and the "extraordinary miracles" happening through Paul there (**Acts 19:8-12**), his work continued to spread the good news of Christ everywhere because it was a natural hub from that place to many locations in Asia Minor & Greece.

Look again at that banner up front that says, "**GRACE MOVES**"... and aren't you glad God's grace still does today what it did back then? Forgiving sin and offering patience when we struggle while restoring us back to God and to each other!? Think about the ocean for a minute... even the sheer size of the world's seas just boggles the mind, doesn't it? The power displayed in the ocean can propel a ship toward its destination more adequately or battle against its destination in futility. For those who have seen the power of the sea, we many times traverse its might according to its will, not our own. Now think about grace and compare it to standing at the shore of the sea... and God's great power shines through! We can feel so small next to the overwhelming love of God expressed to everyone on the planet on a daily basis. Maybe that's the point... our gratefulness, appreciation & lives dedicated to Him emerge from a large dose of that mighty grace of God! May those attitudes make their way in and through us each day as we attempt to contemplate the awesome complexities of the moving grace of God on our behalf!

Today's emphasis/lesson is going to be on Ephesians 2 and that good grace of God yet again. It's God's greatest work in and through us. No matter what we have done, God's grace works to restore us with each new sunrise! And that is very good news!
