Later this year on September 29th, it will be "National Coffee Day". Many of us welcome a cup (or two) each morning. If you wouldn't consider yourself a 'person of prayer' - it's time to pray that God changes your prayer life today for the better! And when God gives you the short dose of alertness - He will also give you a long term effectiveness that will blow your mind! Wake up! Be alert and keep on praying!
