"...redeeming the time, because the days are evil." Ephesians 5:16

"Ephesians 5:16 commands us to get in the habit of "redeeming the time." Time can be lost or wasted, depending on what we did with it. But if we have wasted or lost time along the way, the end is not over! Ephesians 5:16 clearly says we can "redeem" time. The word "redeeming" in this verse is the Greek word exagoridzo. The word agoridzo is the Greek word for a marketplace that's cluttered with products and vast opportunities to spend more time and money shopping there than one ought to use. It was the same then as it is today. If a person isn't careful, he can become lost roaming through the shops of the market, wasting precious time. But that word ex means "out" and is where we get the word exit. When ex is added to the word agoridzo to form exagoridzo, it paints the picture of finding what you need, purchasing it, and getting out of the marketplace quickly. In other words, do what you need to do, and then make an exit!" - Rick Renner

Be careful about how you spend your time - because it's so easy to get distracted and lost in the marketplace of this world! We deal with cultural & personal tendencies on a daily basis that flow away from God. Left to ourselves, we are most likely to end up thinking only about ourselves & serving 'the man in the mirror'. We must go against the flow of feelings, against the grain of culture, and instead of swimming downstream like everyone else, we have to choose to be careful that we live as children of light! This is one way to prove a genuine faith in God... by ***"redeeming the time"*** to be more like Jesus.
