

WORSHIP FROM HOME SUNDAY, MARCH 22 & 29; APRIL 5:

We want to quickly make you aware of our plan to continue worshipping as a congregation as we follow the guidelines of the CDC, federal, and state health organizations concerning COVID-19.

For the next three Sundays we will hold our services online. You can access the online feed through YouTube, Facebook, and our website. We will begin the feed at 9:55 AM with announcement slides and start service promptly at 10 AM. We will NOT assemble as a congregation at the building. We will begin gathering at the building some time after April 5.

We want you to treat our meeting time the same way you would treat coming to church. We ask you to engage in all aspects of worship as you would if you were at the building.

We want to encourage family and friend groups to meet together in their homes (while following the health recommendations of keeping the groups to 10 or smaller). We view this as a great opportunity to invite friends and family over for worship that have been out of church. There is a possibility that you can get some of your friends or family to worship with you over the next few weeks that have not worshipped faithfully in years! This is a great opportunity for our church family!

Please gather communion supplies – grape juice and bread – and prepare to worship from home. Shortly, we will post a simple recipe for communion bread. We encourage members to gather with their families, members of their LifeGroups, or other small circles of friends.

We will have a test run this Saturday at 5 PM. The live will be on for one hour. This will be so that everyone can get on and make sure their technology is working. We encourage children to help their parents and grandparents with this technology. If there is a tech savvy person in your family, you may want to get them to help get things setup the way you prefer.

We ask that all of our members be thoughtful of each other. If you think of someone that may not have family to worship with or the ability to log on to the internet,

please invite them to worship with you! We want to make sure EVERY SINGLE MEMBER is able to worship with us this Sunday!
