SCRIPTURE

Read the passage of Scripture. Write out or underline the verses or phrases that stood out to you from your reading.

TRUTH

What is the principal or theme of the verses? Many times this might be a phrase or word that is repeated or it is a thought that stands out as you read it. Is the spirit highlighting a theme in the verses? What does it say about who God is?

APPLICATION

How does this truth apply to my life and my circumstances? Is it calling me to action? If so describe.

RESPONSE

Talk all right to God about what he is teaching you. This could involve confession, phrase, commitment, request, etc. This keeps your time in the Word a two way conversation. It is sometimes easy to stop at knowledge and not move into response.

1-5 Write down or circle everything that tells you something about God's wrath or judgment. Write down or underline everything that tells us man's faults in sin. How do you see this in your life? What else do you see here?

6-11 Write down or circle places where Paul explains God's justice. What is the requirement Paul mentions for someone to get glory and honor and peace? Are you able to do that? What else do you see?

12-16 Write down or circle the places where the Law is mentioned here. What does Paul say about the Gentiles, who didn't know the Law? Are they still guilty of sin, even though they didn't? Re-read Romans 1:18-20 to help you understand why. What else do you see?

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
