### **SCRIPTURE**

Read the passage of Scripture. Write out or underline the verses or phrases that stood out to you from your reading.

### **TRUTH**

What is the principal or theme of the verses? Many times this might be a phrase or word that is repeated or it is a thought that stands out as you read it. Is the spirit highlighting a theme in the verses? What does it say about who God is?

### **APPLICATION**

How does this truth apply to my life and my circumstances? Is it calling me to action? If so describe.

### **RESPONSE**

Talk all right to God about what he is teaching you. This could involve confession, phrase, commitment, request, etc. This keeps your time in the Word a two way conversation. It is sometimes easy to stop at knowledge and not move into response.

## **WEEK 7 - ROMANS 3:21-31**

21-26 **Righteousness is living rightly according to God's Word. Write down or circle everything that talks about righteousness. How does our righteousness measure up? How is God shown to be righteous and when (verse 25)? What else do you see here?**

27-31 **Paul has spent the last two chapters (1:18-3:8) showing how neither Gentiles nor Jews are blameless before God. How does He regard Jews now? How about Gentiles? Since that includes everyone, are there different ways that each group needs to be saved? What is the way to salvation? What else do you see?**

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
