Calvary 101: Are you interested in learning more about Calvary and what the next steps might be for you? If so, we would love to have you stick around next Sunday after the service. Grab a cup of coffee, and head on down to the Lounge, so that we can meet you!

Children's Worship is a ministry for kids ages 3 through 1st grade during the worship service, led this week by Joy/Rosie. Children and teachers are dismissed before the sermon. Kids can be picked up by parents/guardians from the Children's Worship room (close to the nursery) after the service.
