Jesus Before Pilate, Part 2 John 19:1-11

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Introduction

John 18 & 19 are a picture of the utter rebellious, hateful sinfulness of man

From man's perspective this is a miscarriage of justice, by God's design this is a <u>substitutionary</u> application of justice

Barabbas – bar means "son of", abba means "the father"

The **Humiliation** by the Romans

- The flogging is a <u>light whipping</u>, intended to make the point "keep your nose clean"
- Jesus is being humiliated, shamed, and disgraced for all to see

The Hubris of the Jews

- Cry out is not merely loud, but uncontrollable rage
- Jesus has not "made Himself" anything, the Son of God is who He is
- Those who claim to uphold God's word reject the <u>word of God made flesh</u> standing in front of them

The **Haunting Compromises Besetting Pilate**

• There's a growing fear in Pilate Jesus is far more than Pilate has understood

The Hope-filled Providence of the Sovereign God

- Jesus chooses humiliation because Jesus' Father is in control here
- Pilate's authority is a derived authority, it comes from another
- Pilate's authority over Jesus is subordinate to God's authority over Pilate
- Our hope comes not from the powerlessness of our enemies, but from our Heavenly Father's <u>sovereign rule over</u> their power

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
