4. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. says, "Faith is taking the first step, even when you don't see the full staircase." Abraham's first step of faith was as simple as agreeing that God was able to give him a son in his old age and being willing to wait on his timing for the promise fulfillment. What is an area of your life where God is calling you to faith? What does it look like for you to take a step of faith there?
