Listed below are some new and other great resources for adults and kids as you travel or sit on the deck or relax by the pool with an iced tea or lemonade.

Adult:

Two Weeks by Karen Kingsbury (FIC/KIN), newest book in *The Baxter Family Collection*.

Others in the series: Love Story, In This Moment, To the Moon & Back, When We Were Young.

Whose Waves These Are by Amanda Dykes (FIC/DYK) - her debut novel. It's a powerful story of lives touched by waves. Love and forgiveness and redemption are woven throughout.

Never Let Go by Elizabeth Goddard (FIC/GOD) is the first book in the *Uncommon Justice* series

Secrets at Cedar Cabin by Colleen Coble (FIC/COB) is one of the books in the *Lavender Tides* series. Others in this series: The View from Rainshadow Bay, The House at Saltwater Point. Also check out *A Sunset Cove* series: Mermaid Moon, The Inn at Ocean's Edge, Twilight at Blueberry Barrens.

Breach of Trust by Rachel Dylan (DYL) is the third book in the *Atlanta Justice* series. The first 2 in this series are Deadly Proof and Lone Witness.

Pelican Point by Irene Hannon (FIC/HAN) is one of five books in the *Hope Harbor* series. The other books in this series: Hope Harbor, Sea Rose Lane, Sandpiper Cove, Driftwood Bay.

Kids:

Keller's Heart by John Gray (E/GRA) is about a little deaf girl named Raven who meets a blind and deaf dog named Keller. Together they show everyone around them that it's okay to be different, and that everyone needs a friend.
