2. How is Jesus calling you today to live out your identity in Him? In what ways is He calling you this week to be a faithful steward of all that He has given you (gifts, talents, abilities, resources, etc.)?

3. Read Exodus 4:1-17. What is the message that God wants Moses to convey? In what ways does God demonstrate His power through Moses?

What are some of the excuses Moses has for not being obedient? How does God's response to Moses encourage you in light of excuses you may have made in the past?

4. Read Acts 5:12-16. What are some of the miracles and signs that the early church experienced? Where else in Scripture do we see these taking place (name as many passages as you can think of)?

What was the ultimate purpose of these miracles, signs, and wonders (re-read the Exodus and Acts passage in light of this question)?

What was the most prominent display of God's power in Scripture? How has the empty grave changed your life?

5. What does it mean to rely on the power of God? What does it look like to cultivate environments, rhythms, and disciplines to grow your faith?
