1. What main idea or point from Sunday's message stood out to you the most? What principle or biblical truth will you apply to your life this week? In two or three sentences, paraphrase Sunday's message?

2. For Vision Sunday, Pastor Jeff said that our theme for 2019 is that "The Church has left the building." What does that sentence mean to you? What are some ways in which your small group can step out and serve this semester?

3. Read Exodus 3:13-22 and Ephesians 2:8-10. What comparisons do you see within these passages? What promises of God do you see within the Exodus passage? Within the Ephesians passage?

Describe a time in your life where God delivered you from something (a sin, a difficult circumstance, etc.). What has God saved you from?

What “good works” has God saved you to? What gifts, talents, and abilities has He given you to edify the church and complete the mission?

4. “The question, you see, is not if we are called to pour our lives out for mission, only where and how.” -JD Greear. What are your thoughts about that quote? What is the overarching mission that all Christ followers are called to live for?

This week, take some time praying about your “where” and “how”. Where has God called you (geographically and positionally) to live for the mission? In what ways is He calling you to pursue this mission?
