## Getting Started...

1. What has been the high point in your life this past week? What has been a low point that your group can be praying for you about?

2. In what ways have you worshipped the Lord this week? What spiritual disciplines have you incorporated into your weekly routine and what disciplines are you trying to include?

## Into the Bible...

3. Read John 13:1-20. What is the lesson that Jesus sets for His followers? What motivates Jesus to do this?

How do we see the gospel within this passage? What can we learn about God's love and purpose from a passage like this?

4. Jesus loved His disciples “to the end” (vs. 1). How would you describe the love of Christ to someone who doesn’t know Jesus? What does the love of Jesus look like in your own life?

Why do you think Peter responded in the manner that he did? Has there ever been a time where you have responded to Jesus’ words in a similar manner?

## **Application**

5. How does love lead a Christ follower into faithful service? What does serving in response to Jesus’ love look like in your own life (in what ways are you serving others)?

What does it mean to be cleansed by Jesus? How have you experienced the cleansing of Jesus in your life? How has that changed your life?
