Lessons in Exodus

Takeaways from Exodus

1 John 1:5-7

We are to escape the **darkness**.

We are to live in the **light**.

2 Corinthians 4:6, Exodus 11:1-10

1. This week, we heard a testimony from a brother who is walking in the light, confronting the darkness of his past with the life-giving truth of Jesus. When did Jesus bring you out of darkness and into the light? Who has God placed in your life that you can share this joyous news with (in speech and in action)?

2. Read Exodus 11:1-11:10. What was Moses' reputation before Pharaoh? What was his reputation like amongst the rest of the nation and the Israelites? Why does God say that Pharaoh will not listen?

Which of the plagues that we have encountered to this point would most terrify or disturb you? Why is it significant in the latter plagues that the people of Israel were spared while Egypt suffered?

3. Read 1 John 1:5-7. What truths about God do we see from this passage? How are we able to have fellowship with God and with others?

What does it mean to have fellowship with God? What is the warning that John gives us in this passage? Take a few minutes of prayerful reflection asking God to reveal whether you are walking in darkness or living in the light.

4. What does it look like to walk in the light? What attributes, characteristics, or qualities will a Christ-follower display in increasing measure as they walk in the light?
