Food for Thought

(Questions and Scriptures for Reflection and Study)

1. What does it mean to know God the Father? How is that even possible for us? What Scripture(s) serve as your foundation for that?

2. Read John 17:20-26. What does it mean that Jesus and God the Father are perfectly one? What examples in Scripture do we see this unity displayed?

How is it even possible for unity to exist in the Church today and what does that look like? How does a unified church compare to the consumer mentality of many in the church today?

Reread verse 20. People will believe through the words of the disciple. If you've accepted Christ as Lord and Savior, you're a disciple. What implications does that have on your life? Who are you actively discipling and who is discipling you? If you are unable to think of an answer to either of these questions, commit to daily prayer this week, asking that God would reveal answers to both and praying for the boldness and courage to reach out to them.

3. Read Hebrews 2:9-10. What does it mean that Jesus brought “many sons to glory”? How was He able to do this?
