Questions and Scriptures for Reflection and Study

1. What were the highlights of Nasser's message? What is something from Sunday's message that stood out to you or that God used to challenge or grow you?

2. Read John 4:1-42 Why was asking a Samaritan woman for water such a controversy in Jesus's time? What might an equivalent controversy look like in today's culture?

In this passage, what does Jesus promise? How does the Samaritan woman react to Jesus's revelation that he is the messiah? How do the Disciples react to the Samaritan woman and the people coming to see Jesus?

3. In this text Jesus talks about food but then says He is fed by doing the will of the Father. He will continue to describe how the fields are ripe with harvest. In what ways do you see Riverlawn laboring in the harvest, sowing and reaping seeds for the Kingdom?

Do you believe Jesus has sent you to harvest? In what ways has the Lord equipped you to serve in His Kingdom? Where has he called you to serve?

4. This week, how will you respond to the invitation of grace extended by your Heavenly Father? Who is someone that you can share Jesus with and extend this invitation of grace to?
