No Problem! We love all people here at GSUMC including children.

Our nursery, and all classrooms for children, are conveniently located down one hallway we refer to as the "Children's Wing". It is located on our upper level behind the sanctuary.

Infants through 3 year olds may be dropped off in our **Nursery** at any time on Sunday mornings. It is the last room on the left of our Children's Wing. Pagers are available during your visit. A **Cry Room** is located at the back of our sanctuary and, if needed, a private **Nursing Station** is set up in the basement of our building, just adjacent to our kitchen.

Two year-olds through 5th graders are dismissed to **Junior Church** for a fun and interactive time of learning just before our morning message. We believe it is of value for children to see adults worship in community. So, after sharing in our morning music, Junior Church offers them a lesson geared especially for their age group. During the 10:00 hour between our two services, classes are available for 3-5 year olds, K-2nd graders and 3rd-5th graders.

All of our **Children's Ministry Volunteers** have had thorough background checks. We value assuring the very best care and responsible discipleship of children at GSUMC.

There are handicap **parking spaces** at the south end of the church building. Two separate entrances are available (white door or glass doors). An **elevator** is located near our coat racks. This elevator provides transport to all three levels of the church. Please feel free to utilize it.

Need **general parking**? If our main, paved lot is full, you may park on either side of the street (please be careful if crossing SR 12), or a small stone lot is available. To access it, exit our main lot and turn right. Turn right again down Beech Street and park in the lot just west of the private pond.
