This means we can let go of past regrets. It means we can put down that backpack full of bricks and leave it on the ground at the foot of the cross.


But do you live YOUR life that way? Or do you keep going back and getting your backpack of burdens? Do you still live your life as a condemned person?

The Urbana Yoke Parish Board met on Wednesday, October 8th for their monthly meeting. Brian Chamberlain opened the meeting with prayer. Board vice-chairman Richard Monce called the meeting to order.

<u>The Secretary's Report</u> submitted by Donna Harmon was presented and approved with a motion by Brian Chamberlain and seconded by Bryan Frank.

<u>The Treasurer's Report</u> was presented and approved with a motion by Tami Overman. It was seconded by Donna Harman.

Pastor Chris's Report:

Mileage total 232.6 miles for September for the amount of \$162.82. This was motioned to Accept this by Brian Chamberlain and 2nd by Richard Monce.

Old Business:

Time off or away:

Chris will be out of the office on October 16th and will work from home. Chris will be out of the office on October 23- 26th to attend the Men's Weekend for the Brethren Way of Christ where he will be the Spiritual Director. Kelly Beutler will speak on Sunday, October 26th.

The new sign is installed and working.

Refresh and Rekindle Ministries with Terri Hinds spoke at the church on September 21st. Approximately \$400 was collected for that ministry. Amplify/Ministry brands- it was decided to try it for six months and then decide.

In New Business for Pastor's Report:

It was decided not to sponsor the WRSW Radio Ad from Warsaw.

Other new business:

Aaron Mattern will be reseeding the ground where the new sign was installed on 10/11/25. He will contact Joe Dirt to fix the flowerbed around the sign.

Committee Reports:

Benevolence: Aaron Mattern reported that his committee has given out gas cards. There were some repairs done for a local person in need. **Program Committee**:

Trustee Report:

He will come back to pressure wash everything from the drainpipe. They are waiting on a quote for smoke and carbon detectors. The furnace is making noise and will get looked at. Old Business: Covered under Pastor's Report

The 2026 Urbana Yoke Parish Proposed Budget was discussed. Rena' increased the Gas budget and the insurance cost to reflect probable increases. The UYP Board suggested and voted on asking for a 10% increase for Pastor Chris for 2026. He was not given any increases last year. Richard Monce made the motion, Bryan Frank seconded it. This would make his salary \$57,200.
