

Lutheran World Relief

On October 14 we delivered all the Lutheran World Relief (LWR) boxes of 101 quilts, 100 school kits, 100 personal care kits, 12 lbs. of rolled bandages, 31 pillowcases to K & B Trucking in South Sioux who deliver them (free of charge to us) to LWR CENTER IN MINNEAPOLIS. LWR then distributes them to those in need nationally and internationally. So thanks to the volunteers here at MLC, you can see that we added significantly to the total of 16 area churches totals. 


