Ministry Initiative

In January of this year, the Church Council called into being a group of people who would help this church deepen our connections with each other, our communities, and with Christ. A team was formed in March and began meeting together to implement that same goal. The members of the team are Jason and Carmen Pease, Darren and Michelle Tooley, Jason and Valerie Kaat, Tracy Ford, Jennica Corporan, Shawn and Kerri Wease, Jay and Haley DeVries, Jay and Jane Krehbiel, and Mark Vander Tuig.

To accomplish all of this, starting on September 20th we are kicking off the study of a book called “Joining Jesus on His Mission”! The author, Pastor Greg Finke, reminds us that Jesus is already at work in the lives of the people around us and we are invited to join Jesus on His mission. It is not complicated, all that is needed are people who are willing. God is sending us into the lives of the people with whom we are already connected—family, friends, neighbors, colleagues, office mates, teachers, nurses, farmers, students, and more.

The best way to understand and apply this simple and well written book is to join with others. On the Sundays of September 13th and 20th, the book “Joining Jesus on His Mission” will be available for you to take home. You will also find a number of small group meeting times and places for you to be a part of. In addition, the sermons over these 8 weeks will be focused on chapters of the book as well. Finally, Mark Vander Tuig’s Wednesday evening study will also be focused on the concepts in the same book starting on September 23rd at 6 pm.

The book is easy to read, and even comes with a one paragraph summary on the last page of each chapter. The book, along with the sermons, and discussion questions in the bulletin, will give each small group more than enough material for discussion and application.

Our Connections Ministry Initiative has another goal. We would very much like to see more and more of our people here at Morningside experiencing the value of the small group model of ministry. It provides a great way to learn, to deepen our understanding, connect more deeply with others, and helps us to grow in our faith. This world desperately needs people who know Jesus, and can show them the love, mercy, and truth of God in Christ. We believe that the Holy Spirit is calling Morningside Lutheran Church to be a part of God’s desire for Siouxland, and the world!

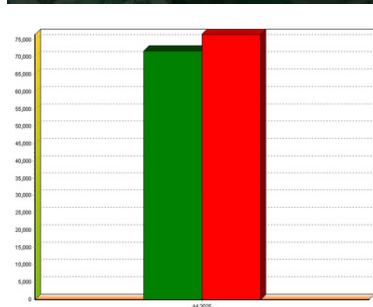

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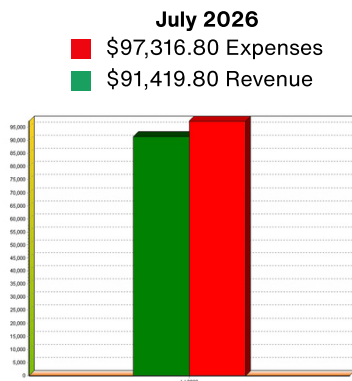
