Entomologists estimate that more than 1 ½ million different types of insects exist in this world and some of their capabilities are truly amazing. Take for example – the bee.

The bee has a brain about the size of a pinhead; yet, it organizes a little city inside it's hive. It builds 10,000 cells for honey, 12,000 for larvae, and a special sanctuary for the queen. When the temperature becomes so warm that the wax begins to soften and the honey is in danger of being lost, squads of little sentinels automatically take their place at the entrance of the hives and create a cooling system with their fast beating wings. Their cooling method puts an electric fan to shame.

In 1719, a French scientist named Rene' Antoine Ferchault de Reaumer, examined a wasp's nest. He noted that it seemed to be made of a type of pasteboard. Upon further investigation, he discovered that most of the material was obtained from tree fibers. Because of his work, the first successful production of paper from wood pulp was achieved. Just think, God had instilled this ability in the wasp from the dawn of history.

All of God's creation is wonderfully made and we are the crown of His creation. Just think of our possibilities!
