It is also a real part of God's church. To paraphrase author Sue Mallory, the body of Christ is a living organism, made up of living parts that are constantly changing in the amazing living miracle called the church.

Session members have been looking at the changes around us at CPC — good changes such as growing numbers of youth and covenant partners, and the blessings of pastors and staff committed to enhancing discipleship and service in our church.
