Q & A for parents: Which childhood friend did you get in the most trouble with? And which friend inspired you to do better?

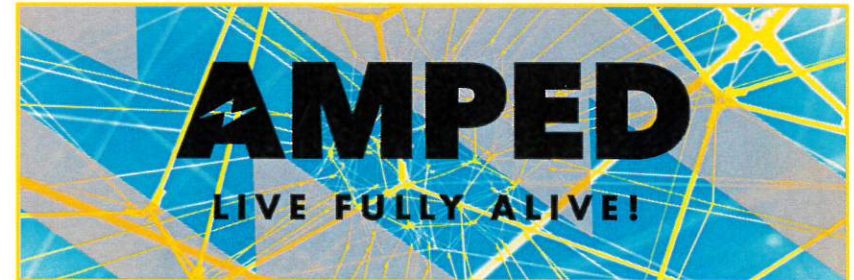


BED TIME
