Job Description

Purpose of Role: The Young Adults Pastor gives oversight to Elim's Young Adult ministry specifically, as well as engaging in other initiatives for Elim Church. This role is a full time, permanent position.

Vision: A strong, vibrant, effective ministry to/for Young Adults.

Task Summary:

- 30% Planning YA weekly service and preparing and delivering sermons
- 30% Leading the YA leadership team/Engaging with leaders
- 20% Pastoral Care/mentoring/prayer with individuals
- 10% Admin/Next Gen Team
- 10% Ministry with/at U of S

Key Tasks:

- Give oversight and direct Elim's ministry to Young Adults. This would include leading the Young Adults Leadership team in all aspects of Elim's YA ministry (Social, Community service, U of S, Community groups, Social media, worship, greeting, snacks, prayer and preaching)
- Act as a liaison to the University of Saskatchewan and develop partnerships between Elim's YA Ministry and our on campus attendees.
- Be present on the U of S campus to encourage and mentor U of S students who are part of YAs
- Prepare weekly YA service
- Prepare & deliver messages on Tuesday nights and assign preaching to others.
- Work with members of the Next Gen Team as they serve the Next Generations of the church (weekly meetings). Develop opportunities to bridge the transition from youth to YA's.
- Meet with individuals for shepherding/mentoring purposes.

- Work with Operations team to integrate YAs into our Elim database.
- Give oversight to recruiting, training and equipping of YA leaders in order to release people to serve in strong lay leadership positions.
- Assist with planning and implementing of YA Retreat's (2x year) as well as providing support/leadership for the YA Conference.
- Provide support, vision, and insight for other church ministries as requested.
- Availability/attendance in weekend services.

Qualities:

The Pastor will be a person who:

- Has a high level of spiritual passion
- Has demonstrated the ability to think clearly and design a strategic plan with measureable results
- Is committed to lifelong learning
- Is able to engage and inspire Young Adults
- Has good public communication skills
- Has good organizational skills; prioritizes duties effectively
- Has a Bachelor of Theology degree or higher
- Is currently credentialed with the PAOC or is eligible for credentials

- Maintain credentials in good standing with the PAOC.
- Must be or become a member of Elim
- Follow and abide by Elim Staff Policies
- Previous Pastoral ministry experience involving Youth or Young Adults
