### **Job Description:**

Elim Church is looking for a Summer Youth Ministry Intern to help with the demanding needs of our summer program and events. This is a great opportunity for those interested in working with youth in a ministry setting. This position will work with and report directly to the Youth Ministry Pastor at Elim Church.

### **Ministry Expectations:**

1. Schedule devotional time with Youth Ministry Director, encouraging growth with God and developing leadership philosophy and skills.
2. Become acquainted with the inner workings of the church and to gain a better understanding of Elim Church.
3. Foster relationships with students in the midst of programs and Bible studies.
4. Build relationships with students; Have relational skills and service orientation.
5. Have fun while looking into ways to stay energized.
6. Be flexible, takes initiative, self-starter, team player and a problem solver.
7. Be able to work in a fast-paced, multi-faceted environment.

### **Student Ministry Duties:**

1. Co-lead Sunday Jr. High program
2. Help with Youth Planning Team
3. Co-Lead Youth summer activities.
4. Work on assigned NextGen Team projects
5. Involvement in assigned Churchwide activities

### **Qualifications:**

- An acknowledgement that Jesus Christ is your Lord and Saviour.
- A desire to continue a strong, committed and mature relationship with Christ.
- An excitement and interest in teaching youth about God.
- Prior leadership experience desired.
- Experience working with youth/teens.

### **The successful candidate must meet the following criteria:**

- is between 18 and 25 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- was registered as a full-time student during the preceding academic year;
- intends to return to school on a full-time basis during the next academic year;
- is a student in a high school, post-secondary, vocational or technical program;

is a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and;

- is legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial / territorial legislation and regulations

The Candidate should also be self-motivated, take initiative, and be an excellent team player. In addition, the candidate should know Christ as their Lord and saviour and be excited and comfortable to work with youth.

Prior experience with youth, teaching, program co-ordinating and/or supervising volunteers is an asset but not required.
