

ALL-IN WITH FAITH COV — PLEDGE GUIDE SHEET

Use this guide sheet to help you think through the ways God may be inviting you to take a next step in the stewardship of your time, talents, and treasure at Faith Covenant Church.

There are some brief explanations of what we mean by time, talents, and treasure as part of our **All-In With Faith Cov** pledge campaign. And there are **lists of serving opportunities and personal “gifts” you might consider**. These are designed to help you narrow your focus to the few things you think God may be inviting you to consider as part of your pledge.

1. Time

Like tithing on our income, we are invited to commit a portion of our time to participate in the shared mission of the faith community we call “home.”

The number of hours we contribute can add up over the course of several weeks. For example, someone might serve two Sundays a month on the Sunday AM Host team (4hrs/month), and also facilitate a Grow Group that meets weekly for 90 minutes (6hr/month). Perhaps a willingness to join another ministry team that meets monthly to plan (2hrs) and also leads a monthly event (2hrs) could be an added commitment (4hrs/month) = Hours: 14hrs/month.

Out of the roughly 480 waking hours we have each month, 14 hours is about 3% of our time.

What is one step you can take in stewarding your time for God’s mission?

2. Talents

We all have natural abilities and skills we’ve developed over time, and these often relate to the ways the Holy Spirit uses us to be a blessing to others. These gifts can be used by God when we serve on a ministry team, facilitate a life group, or connect to another person for mentoring or mutual support and encouragement. Whether our skills are professional or practical, they can be used creatively and in a variety of ways to be a blessing to others.

What is one step you can take in stewarding your talents for God’s mission?

3. Treasure

We all have a different amount of financial resources available to us. But rather than putting our trust in money to provide security, success, and happiness, the Bible invites us to put our trust fully in God for these things. Increasing our generosity and commitment to participate in the mission of God wholeheartedly not only allows us to use what we have to advance God’s kingdom work through our faith community, it also sets us free from being chained to a false hope in something that cannot, itself, set us free.

What is one step you can take in stewarding your treasure for God’s mission?
