CATAPULT BUILDING CONTEST RULES

Catapult "rules"

- Throwing Lever Arm – 10' Long Maximum (from pivot point to launching end).
- Manually powered by 2 boys Maximum (no springs, motors, etc allowed).
- Must be a lashed together structure with ropes or twine. NO nails, screws, tape, wire, etc. allowed.
- MUST be dismantled and properly disposed of following the event.
- MUST be built (assembled) at Camp during the allotted time period (no "pre-made" structures allowed). It is o.k. (and encouraged) to have all of the poles properly cut to size prior to the event.
- Each group must furnish their own supplies (poles, rope, twine, launch pad, etc.). Note: There may be a limited amount of supplies at camp or you may be able to borrow components from another group once they are done...but there are no guarantees.
- ANY device deemed not "safe" by coordinator will be disqualified (Leaders use some wisdom here, lets keep our boys safe while having fun).
- TAKE CARE when using hand tools and knives. Boys should have proper training before using such tools.
- This event is geared towards BOYS. Leaders can give council and advice, but boys should do the actual construction work.
- Catapult event can be done by the entire Outpost or by individual patrols from the same Outpost.
- Water Balloons and further detailed instructions will be provided at Camp.

JUDGES DECIDE ON THE INTERPRETATION OF THE RULES.

Awards

- Best looking/most creative Catapult design.
- Best Construction (correct lashing, number of different types of lashing, etc).
- Furthest distance to launch Water Balloon.
- Most accurate shot.
