Pastor: The 7th Commandment says "You shall not commit adultery."

People: We confess that we have been unchaste and dwelt on lustful thoughts.

Pastor: The 8th Commandment says "You shall not steal."

People: We confess that we have taken those things not rightfully ours, whether time or goods or money.

Pastor: The 9th Commandment says "You shall not bear false witness."

People: We confess that we have been untruthful by giving false impressions, by telling partial truths and by being unfaithful to promises we have made.

Pastor: The 10th Commandment says "You shall not covet."

People: We confess that we have been discontent and longed for the possessions of others.
