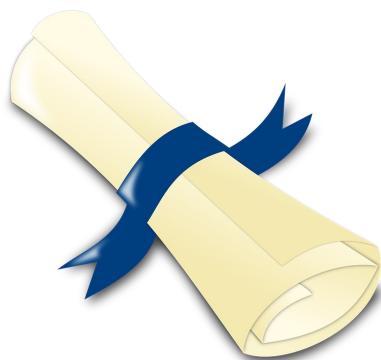
Learn about Bible and Music Camp (BAM Camp),
