Twelve years in the making

*Do you know the simplest way to become
exposed to the whole Bible?*

*Attend the morning and evening worship service,
and over time we will walk you through the whole Bible!*

This evening, in the course of our regular evening worship, we will read Isaiah 66. That may seem like something ordinary, and in many ways it is, but it is also an extraordinary mile marker in the life of our congregation. In 2007, Rev. Terry Johnson, of Independent Presbyterian Church in Savannah, encouraged me to take our Scripture reading in worship in a new direction—read through books of the Bible. People don't read the whole Bible like they should, so we should read it to them. Is it effective? Well, at least three people in our congregation have given testimony (sometimes without even realizing it) that their hearts were first opened to hearing the voice of the Good Shepherd through the reading of Scripture in worship.

And what will we do next? Well, what we've already done, circle back around to hear Him all over again. Such is our gracious privilege!
