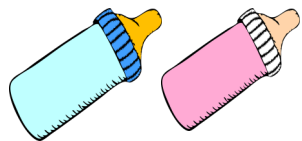
Sharing is Caring

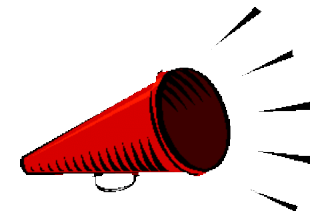
