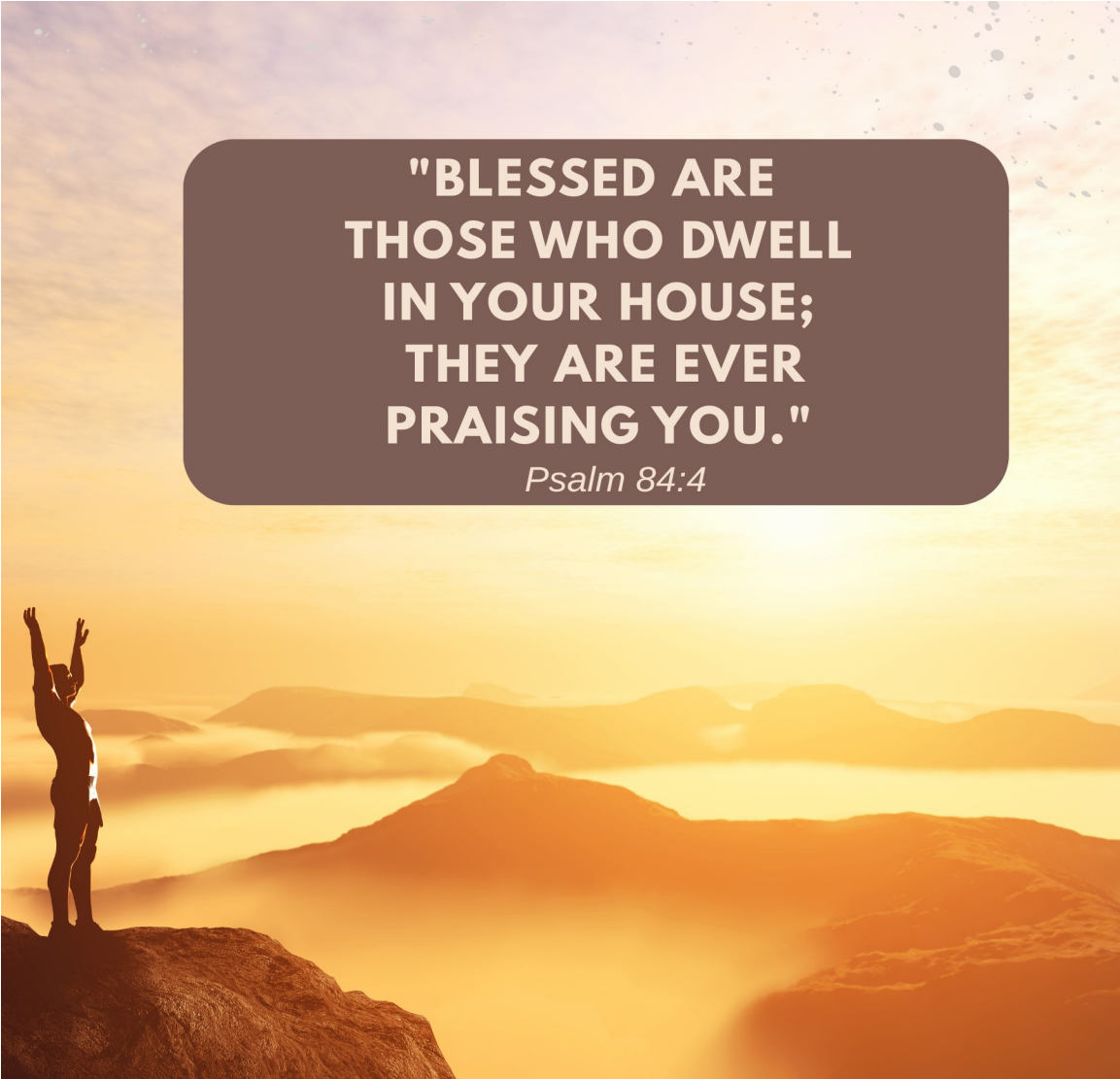

MITS BIT’S: Have you been an encouragement to someone lately? Most of us have interactions with people to some extent almost every day. If we go out, we interact. If we pick up the phone, we interact. If we go online, we interact. We don’t need to do much of anything, really. We just need to exchange ideas (and/or cash!)

with another person. Every time we interact with someone, we have the opportunity to be an encouragement. I led a service at Fairfield Park about 2 weeks ago. In that service, I reminded the residents that they have the ability to be an encouragement to those around them. A courteous “thank you” often goes a long way to making someone else’s day better. The effect can be contagious as the other person interacts with others yet. This same way, however, can be turned around. We can be a discouragement to others too. I suppose it all depends on your demeanor. Are you someone who is generally thankful to God for what your days hold? Or are you more into yourself each day, looking to something else for your happiness? We can’t dismiss how our actions can change another’s day. It might be time for that all-important attitude check!
