

MIT'S BIT'S: If you're anything like me, you're looking at this world we live in and wondering when it will all end. When will this absolute disregard for God and morality cease? When will the culture revert back to some decency? Will we ever see a time when the church will be on the rebound?

But I DO see a resurgence within the culture that suggests that we must turn back to God. It may not be in the mainstream, but the subculture suggests that we cannot go on as a culture unless we turn back to God (repent) and ask for His leniency, His forgiveness. One of the truths of Scripture that spoke out to me lately is from Exodus 20 – The Ten Commandments: "You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments. (Exodus 20:4-6). I believe I am seeing this in real time right now. To be sure, this commandment deals only with idolatry. Not every child will have to bear the punishment for their father's sin (see Ezekiel 18:20). When parents put anything in the place of God, the children will suffer. Be it money, leisure, possessions, work, or anything that takes precedent over and above God, the children suffer, to the 4th generation.

If we take a look back 4 generations, we can see how people started to put other things first in their lives. In the 1960's and 70's, the nation was largely God-fearing. Most people went to church. Most believed. Was everything great? No. But people had faith in God, generally. But as time went on, we realized a turning away. The culture began to embrace its prosperous ways, and went on to turn to other gods. Suddenly the golf course became the place where men went to worship. Theatres were the gathering places to meet people. Many people worked hard at dodging work. The land chose another god, any other god over the Almighty One. But after decades of decline, I believe we are seeing a resurgence for the Lord. This is more than a revival. This is a groundswell of younger people who realize that purpose is only found in the Lord. They see the reality of absolute truth and are just beginning to become active in the faith. They realize the faults of the earlier generations and are moving toward the Lord. Praise God that He keeps His promises! Bring on the next generations!

Thrive Faith Formation Tip - As a part of his Sermon on the Mount, Jesus told the disciples, "Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?" (Matt. 6:26, NIV). Spend some time this week watching birds. Go on a hike near a body of water, put a bird feeder in your backyard, or simply watch for birds as you travel throughout your day. As you observe these creatures, be reminded of God's care and provision. Make a list of the ways God provides for you daily.
