GOING DEEPER

Questions for Reflection

When have you experienced an unexpected "divine interruption" in your life that initially seemed inconvenient but later proved transformative?

How do you typically respond when God calls you to step out of your comfort zone, especially during times of exhaustion or disappointment?

In what ordinary moments of your daily life might you be missing God's extraordinary presence?

At-Home Activity: Sacred Moments Journal

Purpose: To practice recognizing God's presence in daily life. Keep a small journal for one week and follow these steps:

- Each evening, write down three ordinary moments from your day.
- For each moment, reflect on how God might have been present.
- Note any "interruptions" that may have actually been divine appointments.
- At the end of the week, review your entries and identify patterns of God's presence in your daily life.
