



Friendship Clothing Ministry

Purpose: To show care by providing quality clothing.

Isaiah 58:7 *Share your food with the hungry, and give shelter to the homeless. Give clothes to those who need them...*

We want to provide excellence with our clothing ministry. Our community needs to know that they can receive quality garments for free at Friendship during their time of need.

The following is the foundation of a clothing ministry of excellence:

Donations:

- Clean clothes that are in good condition. A good rule of thumb is children's clothing that a child could wear to school or adult clothing that an adult could wear to work or a casual setting.
- No torn or stained clothing
- No used undergarments (underwear, bras, etc.)
- No bathing suits
- No mismatched or extremely worn shoes
- No house wares, decorations, appliances, toys, furniture, etc. We partner with the Compassion Coalition on all furniture donations and ask that furniture and all other non-clothing items not be donated to Friendship due to facility limitations.
- A gift-in-kind receipt for donations will be given upon request

Distribution:

- The area and aisles must remain clean and uncluttered by boxes
- All items must be hung on hangers or folded and placed on shelves
- One bag per person unless other circumstances require additional clothing
- Racks along wall with no freestanding racks
- Sizing shall be together with a men's area, women's area, and children's area
