

AMERICA: 250 YEARS

As believers, we recognize that our nation is in deep need of spiritual awakening. Across history, God has moved in powerful ways when His people humbled themselves, prayed, repented, and returned to Him wholeheartedly. Movements such as “Revival 250” can serve as reminders that the greatest need in America is not merely political, cultural, or economic—it is spiritual.

Christians can deeply love their country, pray for its leaders, and work toward righteousness in society without confusing America with the Kingdom of God.

Revival does not come through political power or national identity. True revival comes through the work of the Holy Spirit changing hearts, renewing churches, and drawing people to repentance and faith in Christ. Our mission is not to “take over” the nation, but to faithfully represent Jesus within it.

As the church, we can participate in praying for revival while remaining centered on the Gospel rather than political ideology. We honor Christ best when our allegiance to Him remains greater than our allegiance to any nation, movement, or platform.

May we pray earnestly for America—not out of fear or political ambition—but out of a sincere desire to see hearts transformed by the saving power of Jesus Christ.
