### *News From the Field*

**Argentina** - Bruce Berry just returned from San Miguel de Tucuman where he was visiting a young missionary couple, Joshua and Abigail Owens and their son, Matthew. Their church, Bethel Baptist Church is thriving and growing. Joshua is currently doing double duty covering the work of his father, Larry Owen in the town of Terma about 1 ½ hour drive from Tucuman. Joshua has an Evangelistic team that goes with him on Thursday and Friday evenings to reach the people of Terma. The week Bruce was with them they brought in 140 people for a Saturday afternoon meeting at Zion Hill Baptist Church and five received salvation through Jesus Christ.

Sunday back in Tucuman for Sunday services at Bethel Baptist Church where they have a large bus ministry that brought in 80 first time attenders of which 30 received Christ as their Savior.

**Dominican Republic** – The Sykes Family reports that summer has arrived with daily temperatures at 90+ already. But God, is blessing their efforts. Natasha, one of their new converts this year, eager to *do something* approached a local Nursing Home about holding a service for their residents. Since the school year has just finished, Sara Sykes took her class to the home. The residents were encouraged and Natasha was encouraged to see her efforts bear fruit.

Recently Miguel, one of the young men that Jason has been pouring into for the past three years, preached to their university small group which Jason took with him to a church plant. Jason reports that "watching him stand before the congregation and preach with passion and poise was a great reminder of why he was called to be a missionary".
