Missions Spotlight

The most powerful verse in the Bible has to be John 3:16. It certainly is the best known and most quoted verse. Therefore, the saddest statement we read from some of our foreign missionaries located in “closed” countries is ***“we ask you not post our newsletter on any social media, or anywhere on the internet”***. Their fear is that the authorities of the godless country they are serving in will come and shut them down. Their mission is to teach the people that ***“God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”***

The good news is the Gospel of Jesus Christ because He is the way, the truth and the light and He was given to the world that if any should believe and call upon His name for salvation, they could have eternal life. And because of faithful support we have men, women and families stationed all over the world giving out this gospel message. In some places it is much more difficult than others. In the closed countries it is usually limited to a one-on-one basis.
