Have you ever seen a mother duck or goose on a cold day? Have you seen how the mother selflessly tucks her little ones under the covering of her wings? Scripture shares a great deal about how this relationship is much like the one we have with our Heavenly Father.

Psalm 57:1 I will take refuge in the shadow of your wings until the disaster has passed.

Psalm 61:4 I long to dwell in your tent forever and take refuge in the shelter of your wings.

Psalm 63:6-8 I think of you through the watches of the night. Because you are my help, I sing in the shadow of your wings. I cling to you; your right hand upholds me.

Psalm 91:2-4 I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust." Surely, he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence. He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.

It is one thing to say with your mouth that you trust God; it is a whole different thing to actually trust Him. For example: God has said that He forgives us for our sins, yet we often hold our sins against ourselves. In our storms of life, God has a tendency to be pretty good at carrying us through storms, yet we have a tendency to think we need to do it all on our own. Truth is that we need to literally trust that God has our best interests in mind in the spiritual and physical parts of our life. In God we trust!

Tools to Sharpen Your Faith from Ruth 2:1-4

Pray: Make a list of the people you're praying for. As you pray through your list, ask God how He would like you to be the one to meet someone's need, and respond if He calls you to action. **Encourage:** Look back on the characteristics of Boaz outlined in this session. Find someone you

know who displays the same valor, loyalty, and honor. Tell them what you see in them and how their character inspires you.

Reflect: Think about a time in your life when God provided for your needs. Reflect on what God taught you and how He matured you through that situation. Thank Him for caring for you.

Draw: What does it mean to you to take refuge under God's wings? Create artwork that reflects how you feel about God's protection and provision.

Serve: Ruth sacrificially served Naomi by gleaning in the fields. Find a place to sacrificially serve this week. Ask around at church, volunteer at a local shelter, or contact a charity.
