The Sufficiency of Scripture

"WE FIRMLY BELIEVE THAT THE TRUTH REVEALED IN SCRIPTURE IS ENTIRELY SUFFICIENT TO MEANINGFULLY AND RELEVANTLY ADDRESS AND FULFILL EVERY PERSON'S SPIRITUAL NEEDS IN EVERY SITUATION, IN EVERY PERIOD OF TIME."

This statement from our training manual is representative of the conviction that any true biblical counselor has within his/her heart: THE BIBLE IS SUFFICIENT! Such a conviction is important in a day when many churches and Christian counseling centers are undiscerningly importing worldly philosophies into their pulpits and counseling ministries. These worldly philosophies are often nicely decorated with Christian terminology, but at their core they directly contradict the Word of God. Such antithetical philosophies can ultimately do only one thing when preached or taught: DAMAGE SOULS. Due to the proliferation of false teachers and their contra-Scriptural teachings, we must be careful to heed the exhortation given in 1 John 4:1: "Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world."

Whether it is from the pulpit, from the counseling table, from family members, friends, or people on the internet, we must all be very careful when it comes to submitting our souls to various teachings and teachers. We especially need to be careful to protect our brothers and sisters in their times of weakness, for at such times they can be more vulnerable to be carried away by false teachings that will spiritually cripple them. For these and

other reasons, there is a great need for trained biblical counselors and solid biblical counseling centers. Please be in prayer for the 100+ students in six states who are currently taking our Basic Training Course in Reformed Biblical Counseling, along with the ten students currently receiving advanced training towards counseling certification. Pray also for the counselors at all of the Shepherd's Way Biblical Counseling Centers, and for all of our supervising counselors who are mentoring new counselors. Finally, please pray that the LORD will bless the efforts being made to establish new centers in Kalamazoo, Michigan and in Lynden, Washington.

We are so thankful to the LORD for the success He has granted in fulfilling objectives associated with our <u>passion</u> and <u>purpose</u> this year, as well as in the years past. God raised up 550+ students to complete our *Basic Training Course in Reformed Biblical Counseling* between 2012 and 2023, and He has raised up 100+ new students who are currently taking the class.

The LORD has also allowed the class to be offered in twelve different states across the US, and last year it was offered in two locations in the Philippines (see pictures to the right). Discussion to host the class next year in two countries outside the US is underway, with additional inquiries about the class coming from other international locations as well. 

IRBC Board Piloting New Class Format

The IRBC board recently decided to pilot a new class format that would involve having future students of the IRBC Basic Training Course in Reformed Biblical Counseling watch the majority of the counseling lectures on their own. The students would meet together once per month throughout the duration of the course to discuss the lectures they independently watched. This new format would hopefully allow more students to take the course, as many have been inhibited from



registering due to the requirement of meeting weekly for class sessions. We thank IRBC Supervising Counselor, Nick Kellogg, and the Kalamazoo counseling class for their willingness to assist the board in this piloting project.

While social media has many benefits, it can also cause many problems if it is abused or misused. This point is emphasized in one of the lectures provided in the *IRBC Basic Training Course in Reformed Biblical Counseling*. One of the problems that comes to expression around the counseling table is the divisiveness and hostility that social media can cause. People are often more willing to type comments or make posts using words they would never say to someone's face. With wisdom from Proverbs, Jeff Johnson offers five practical questions that can help us cultivate wisdom in our use of social media in his book, *Taming the Fingers: Heavenly Wisdom for Social Media*:
