- 1. What is God teaching you in the Bible and *how is it affecting your life this week?***
 - + R.E.A.P. (see reverse) or other personal Bible study? + Bible teaching from NoHo Church or elsewhere?
- 2. How is God using you to make disciples *this week?***
 - + Proclaiming the Good News to non-believers with words and deeds?
 - + Using your God-given abilities to teach and serve other believers?
- 3. Do you have any sin to confess and *how can we help?***
 - + Fear? Anxiety? Sexual Sin? Laziness? Pride? Greed? Disunity? Anything else?

RESPONSES

Let us encourage you with this...

+ Passage from the Bible + Something good we see in your life + The hope of Jesus' return & heaven

Let us pray for you...

+ Regarding what you've shared + As God brings other things to our minds

R.E.A.P. (Read, Examine, Apply, Pray) is a straightforward way to process what you're reading in the Bible, either on your own or with a small group of people. *(from The Austin Stone)*

READ

Open your Bible and ask the Holy Spirit to teach, correct, and train you. As you're reading, ask these questions:

- + What is happening in this passage? What things are emphasized, repeated, related?
- + What do you see about God? What is God doing in this passage?
- + What do you see about man?

EXAMINE

Spend some time reflecting. Ask yourself these questions, and write down your thoughts:

- + How do you think the author wants his audience to respond?
- + What do you learn about God's character?
- + What wrong beliefs about God and myself did I have?

APPLY

After examining the passage, apply the text to your own life. Ask yourself these questions:

- + How do I need to repent? What truths do I need to believe? What false beliefs must I turn from?
- + What can I do – empowered by the Holy Spirit – today to apply this passage?

PRAY

Pray through the passage and your application, asking God to change your heart and to change your life, based on the time you've spent in God's Word.
