Devotions in 5 Steps

Pray:

Start by asking God to provide understanding and conviction through His truth.

Observe:

What is the passage trying to say?
Read through the passage carefully. Mark important ideas or words. Outline the thoughts as presented in the passage.

Interpret:

What does this passage mean?
Take time to look up unfamiliar words/concepts with reliable sources. Look to other passages to give understanding. Define the idea or principle.

Apply:

How does God want me to respond to this passage?
Think of a practical way you can use this passage to change your thinking, feeling, or living. Think of real life examples.

Pray Again:

Talk to God about what you have learned. Pray over the ways you need those truths to apply to your life.
