NEW FELLOWSHIP BUILDING UPDATE

The New Fellowship Building Team extends our heartfelt thanks to each of you for all your support and your patience as our completion date has been delayed due to record amounts of rainfall over the past weeks and months.

The building is complete, cleared for occupancy by inspectors, and we anticipate delivery of final interior and kitchen furnishings in the next few weeks. Our biggest obstacle remaining is the completion of paving and marking of the driveways and parking areas. In order to obtain the best foundation for paving we simply have to wait for drier conditions. Our paving contractor will move forward to completion at such time as they feel conditions are optimal for installation of the asphalt, thereby assuring the long-term durability of their work.

It has been the opinion of our team and our contractor that utilization of the building without the completion of paving would simply be too much of a risk, as the wet weather would certainly promote the transfer of grit, dirt and water into the facility. With these abrasive particles carried into the building, it would have a deteriorating effect on the floor coverings as well as causing added janitorial work to maintain the floors to acceptable standards. We humbly ask for your patience and understanding as our long-awaited opening is just over the horizon!

Again, thank you for your prayers, your support and for your longstanding patience in this record breaking year of rainfall!
