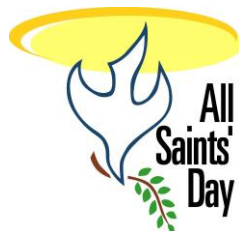
UNITED METHODIST WOMEN ITEMS
