## HOLY COMMUNION AND ANOINTING WITH OIL

The Global Methodist Church (GMC) emphasizes a traditional Wesleyan theology, placing a strong priority on compassionate ministry, altar calls, and spiritual healing. Scripture strongly affirms ministries of spiritual healing, which in recent years have received renewed emphasis throughout Christ's holy Church. Spiritual healing is God's work of offering persons balance, harmony, and wholeness of body, mind, spirit, and relationships through confession, forgiveness, and reconciliation. Through such healing, God works to bring about reconciliation between God and humanity, among individuals and communities, within each person, and between humanity and the rest of creation. The New Testament records that Jesus himself healed the estranged and sick and sent out his disciples on ministries of healing. James (5:14–16a) calls us also to pray for and anoint the sick, that they may be healed. Healing and anointing services provide believers with prayer, laying on of hands, and anointing with oil as tangible expressions of Christ's love.
