The cure for this problem is to count our blessings and be grateful. When we see all the ways that God has blessed us in our life, we begin to see life in a different way. Philippians 4:8 tells us, "Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is

admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things." So start counting your blessings and celebrate how good God is!




