For Preschoolers (2-5)

During every service hour (Sundays at 9:45 and 11:00 a.m., and Wednesdays at 7:00 p.m.) our church offers full classes and care for children of all ages.

This is from a dedicated group of folks who love children, and have a passion in sharing God’s love and Word with them.



Our Nursery for ages 23 months and younger is in room 203 upstairs. If you feel more comfortable bringing your infant into the Chrysalis service with you, you are welcome to do that as well.



Preschoolers start in their rooms by age (see upstairs map) and participate in Preschool Church (Room 100) from 10:15-10:45, and then have class at 11:00 a.m. In both hours children learn Bible stories and have fun!



For Children (Grades K-5th):

During the 11:00am hour, grades 1-3 attend Children’s Church, in room 100, unless you would like for them to attend the worship service with you.

There are two worship services that take place at 11:00am on Sunday morning, on either end of the church building.

The Blended Service includes musical worship, both hymns and praise choruses, and utilizes an organ and piano, accompanied by the choir. Our Senior Pastor, Mark Blair, delivers the morning sermon.

The Chrysalis service includes musical worship, both hymns and modern worship songs, led by a praise band of guitars, drums, and various instruments. Our Associate Pastor, Jonathan Goodman, delivers the morning sermon.

Connect (Sunday School)

At First Baptist, we believe that a vital part of someone's relationship with Jesus Christ is to grow together with other believers. The main way that we do that as a church body is through Sunday School.

Some of our classes are arranged by age or gender, and other classes are arranged by course material. You are welcome to try different classes out, and be sure to consult the map included in this packet.

One helpful piece of information for you is that Sunday School tends to start at 10:00am, with classes gathering for fellowship time and prayer between 9:45am-10:00am.

Adult Sunday School Classes

Age/Gender Separated Classes:

20-Somethings & College – Coed class of folks in their 20s, Room 120.

30 Somethings – Coed class of folks mostly in their 30s, Room 124.

Deaf Class – Coed class for our Deaf, Conference Room.

Women 2 – Women, ranging from their 40s-60s, Room 115.

Men 3 – Men, ranging from their 50s-60s, Room 122.

Women 4 – Women, ranging from their 60s-80s, Room 202.

Men 4 – Men, 60s and up, Room 201.

Women 5 – Women, 60s and up, Room 200.

Singles 50+ - Coed Singles in their 50s and up, Room 210.

Thematic Classes (Coed):

Bible Studies for Life. This theme is split into two classes. One is typically made up of parents with children at home, and adults in their 40s-50s (Room 121) and the other is made up of slightly older adults, mostly in their 50s-60s (Room 126). Bible Studies for Life is a curriculum to connect the Word of God to your everyday world.

Explore the Bible – In this curriculum a class walks through different books of the Bible, little by little. Our current Co-Ed class participating in Explore the Bible meets in Room 125.


