"Poison in the Church"

There is poison in the Church: Jew-haters that attack God's heritage, proclaiming God is finished with Israel and all the promises to Israel now belong to the Church. They spew fables and doctrines of demons. By denying the promises of God to Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, David and Israel, the nation He created to be His witnesses, they deny the Word of God. Holding the truth in unrighteousness, they are part of the falling away from the faith in the latter days seeking to drag others away with them.

This poison is, obviously, detrimental to the health of the Body of Christ and will be purged by the Lord. Will they be refined by the fire of the Tribulation when Israel is the witness on earth of Jesus Christ and the faithful Church is in heaven with the Lord? Do they face an Esua-like burden of the Lord (Obadiah, Mal 1:1-4, Ezk 25:12-14, Amos 1:11-12)? Are they being addressed in Matt 7:21-23? Will they find themselves among the goats on the left hand of the Lord (Matt 25:41-46), having not "done unto the least of these, My brethren" and therefore not having done unto Him (Matt 25:40)? Are they the synagogue of Satan in Rev 3:9-10? What will the Holy One of Israel, the King of Israel, say to them at His judgment seat?

Oh Church, study to shew yourself approved unto God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth! The antidote to poison is unadulterated Truth. Stand on the Truth and contend for the faith (Jude 3, 21-23).
