Good vs. Good

There are a great many “good” people who do not believe in Jesus Christ. They are highly moral people who, on balance, do more good than bad, even overwhelmingly more good than bad. They cannot see that they are in eternal danger because they are self-deceived by their own “goodness.”

Jesus tells us what “good” means. It means God (Matt 19:17), and God is perfect (Matt 5:48). Therefore, “good” means perfect. Anything or anyone less than perfect is evil.

To an unbelieving man, “good” is a balance with more good than bad tipping the scales. But to God, “good” is an absolute, a state of perfection, and all people fall short (Rom 3:10, Rom 3:23, Rom 7:18). Believers in Jesus Christ are not good people but, by grace through faith, they are “in Christ”, Who is perfect (Heb 4:15).

All “good” people standing on their own goodness desperately need Jesus Christ (1 Cor 15:3-4, John 15:5) to enter into eternal life in the kingdom of God (1 Cor 15:50).
